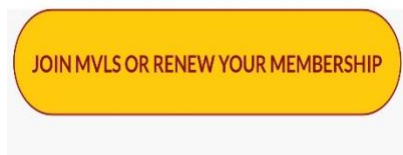


How to join Muriwai Junior Surf

New Members:

1. Go to www.muriwaisurf.org.nz
2. Click on MEMBERSHIP This takes you to the page titled “Join or Renew Your Membership” – scroll down to this link
3. Click on this link



4. Click on “Family Registration”



5. Add “Primary Caregiver” details – this is the adult registered with the child
6. Scroll down and click tab “Choose groups” - choose “Associate Member” or “Active Lifeguard” if one parent is a lifeguard.

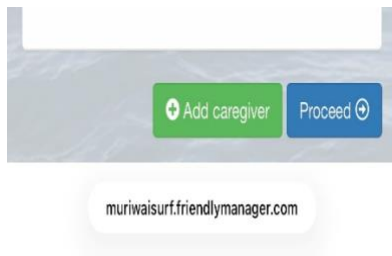

7. If adding another caregiver scroll down further and click “Add Caregiver” and fill in Caregiver 2’s details, choose “Additional Caregiver” under “Choose Groups” button

9. Click “Proceed” at the bottom of the page

10. Fill in child’s details under “Family Members”

11. Click “Choose Groups” button at the bottom of the page and choose:

- Tadpoles (U7)
- A Group (U8, U9 or U10) then choose which one
- B Group (U11 or U12) then choose which one
- C Group (U13 or U14) then choose which one

12. Click “Add Member” if you want to add more children then follow steps 10 and 11 for each child.

13. When all children have been added click “Proceed”

14. This takes you to the “Donation” page where you can purchase a swim cap, high viz vest or beanie – or make a donation. Note all junior surf children are required to wear a high viz vest and beanie to participate in club days.

- If you wish to purchase an item, click “Purchase” and click on the item to add it to your shopping cart (choose the person the item is for)
- If you wish to make a donation, click “Donation” and click on the donation amount you would like to make
- If you don’t wish to purchase or make a donation, click “Purchase” and “Already have this item” then “Proceed”

15. Accept Terms and Conditions and click “Proceed”

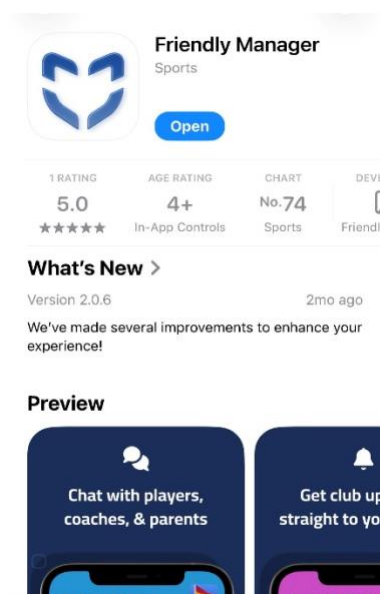

16. This will take you to the payment page.

17. Once you have completed a registration you will receive an email with a link to reset your password. To make any further registrations you will need to log into your profile to register using the login box.



18. You can then download the Friendly Manager App from an app store (Google Play or Apple App store). To connect with Muriwai Volunteer Lifeguard Service on the app, and be kept up to date with everything happening at the club, click “Register” and enter the join code **FJ136-QR522**



IMPORTANT

If this is your first time joining a Surf Club you also need to join Surf Lifesaving New Zealand through the link below – you only need to do so once, whereas your Muriwai Surf Club Registration needs to be renewed each season.
